Labor Day Weekend Enforcement A Success

The Flagler County Sheriff's Office conducted a Labor Day traffic initiative for awareness, enforcement and education. Statistics show the initiative was a success.

From September 1st through September 4th, Sheriff's deputies conducted 308 traffic stops, 53 boat stops, two arrests for DUI, and no traffic fatalities within Flagler County.

"These holiday operations are a great education tool to remind everyone to drive and boat safe," Sheriff Rick Staly said. "Our team was highly visible and engaged in traffic and boater safety. I'm thankful our roads and waterways were safe this Labor Day weekend in Flagler County with no traffic fatalities."

Patrol squads had increased countywide presence and DUI enforcement with motorcycle, bike, beach and patrol units. Marine units also patrolled the intra-coastal and canal waterways. Message boards were present countywide to remind drivers to "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over." The FCSO's Sheriff-Taxi car was also on display.
