FCSO Assists Federal Authorities on Two Fugitive Arrests

Deputies of the Flagler County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) assisted federal authorities with locating and apprehending William Tobias-Elliott Tinsley and Jocelyn McLaughlin at 11 Raintree Lane in Palm Coast on Friday. Both subjects had active warrants from St. Johns County.

William Tobias-Elliott Tinsley had two active warrants for sale of oxycodone and trafficking in a controlled substance. He was also charged with possession of methadone at the time of his arrest. His bond is set at \$160,000.00.

Jocelyn McLaughlin, DOB 3/15/1996, had an active warrant for neglect of a child. Her bond was set at \$5,000.00. Both subjects were booked into the Flagler County Detention Facility and then transferred to St. John's County.

"We were called to assist to get these fugitives off the street," Sheriff Rick Staly said. "Opiates are a plague to our country and we will continue to hunt down those who peddle this poison in our community. These two thought Flagler County would be a good place to hide out, but they were wrong. We stand ready to work with all law enforcement partners to make our county and country safer."
