## **Month-long Investigation Nets Two Arrests**

The Flagler County Sheriff's Office Special Investigations Unit with the assistance of a Sheriff's Office tactical team executed a search warrant at 32 Woodstone Lane in Palm Coast just before 8:00 a.m. on Thursday morning. Three residents were home at the time that the warrant was executed: Tanya Denise McGrew, Marvin McGrew Jr, and Gregory Lamar Williams Jr.

When detectives arrived on scene and announced their presence for the search warrant, Marvin McGrew Jr refused to exit the residence. A detective observed McGrew peek out through the blinds and the detective gave verbal commands for McGrew to exit the residence. He did not comply but was soon met by tactical members and taken into custody.

The search of the home found a quantity of narcotics in the guest bathroom toilet. McGrew had attempted to flush the narcotics in an effort to destroy evidence. Detectives were able to recover the evidence from the toilet and drainpipe. Narcotics and paraphernalia were also located throughout the home in common areas as well as in the bedrooms of the two defendants.

"These are known poison pushers in our community and we will continue to go after all drug dealers until they change their profession or get out of Flagler County," Sheriff Rick Staly said. "Our Special Investigations detectives did a great job in building this case and taking these offenders off the streets."

In total, detectives seized 20 oxycodone tablets, approximately 2 grams of crack cocaine, approximately 2 grams of an unknown brown powder substance that will be sent off for chemical analysis, approximately 14.5 grams of cannabis, and drug paraphernalia.

Marvin McGrew Jr, 26, was arrested and charged with possession of crack cocaine with intent to distribute, possession of oxycodone, tampering with evidence, possession of cannabis, and possession of drug paraphernalia. Gregory Lamar Williams Jr, 24, was arrested and charged with possession of oxycodone. Williams was just released from prison in November of 2017.

This is an ongoing investigation and further charges are pending.
