### **Who Will Sheriff Staly and his Posse ‘Arrest’ at Second Annual Relay for Life Jail’n Bail?**

Sheriff Rick Staly will be patrolling the streets and serving warrants to public officials and participating citizens to raise money for the Relay for Life at the second annual Jail’n Bail on March 23. Sheriff Staly will “arrest” the participants and transport them to “jail” at the Hilton Garden Inn where they will have to make bail (via donations to the American Cancer Society) in order to bond out.



This is the second year that the Flagler County Sheriff’s Office (FCSO) has participated in the Relay for Life “Jail’n Bail” fundraiser. Last year Sheriff Staly made several arrests, including Santa Claus who had a “warrant” for multiple breaking and entering of occupied dwellings as well as operating an aircraft without a pilot’s license. The Sheriff himself was even arrested after a good natured warrant was taken out by his own wife for “working too many hours.”

Arrestees will have the privilege of making more than just one phone call, text or e-mail as they reach out to friends and associates to raise enough “bail money” to be released from “jail.”

“Usually crime does not pay- but this fundraiser generates huge donations for cancer research so we are proud to be a part of it,” Sheriff Staly said. “Fighting cancer and fighting crime go hand in hand, as both touch all of us.”

Money raised from the Jail’n Bail will help the American Cancer Society provide information and support for people affected with cancer and will fund cancer research projects to help protect future generations.
