Detective Annie Conrad Selected as Flagler County 2018 CrimeStoppers Officer of the Year

Sheriff Rick Staly, Chief Steve Brandt, and Chief Mark Strobridge attended the Crime Stoppers' of NE Florida 20th Annual Banquet along with Detective Annie Conrad and her family. Deputy Conrad was selected as the Law Enforcement Officer of the Year for Flagler County for her outstanding service to the community and handling intricate major cases. Detective Conrad had been nominated by Sheriff Staly for the prestigious award.

Detective Conrad was nominated for her investigation of a reported missing person, Charles Singer. Her

dedication to unearthing the truth resulted in the arrest of Dorothy Singer in May of 2017 for the murder of her husband, Charles Singer. Detective Conrad was walking the Singer' property when she noticed something odd in the backyard—debris and a boat that seemed out of character with the surroundings. She documented the scene and days later served a search warrant on the property and unearthed the badly decomposed body of Charles Singer.
