Man Pistol-Whips Friend, Fires Round in Town Center

Flagler County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the Target Shopping Plaza on State Road 100 in Palm Coast on Saturday evening around 8:40 p.m. after reports of a fight and the discharging of a firearm. No one was shot.

A man, Matthew Bauman, reported to deputies that he was in a fight with another man, Christopher Quijano, 19, in the parking lot in front of the Ross store and that Quijano pistol-whipped him. Matthew had bleeding lacerations to his face and ear consistent to a pistol whipping. During the altercation, Quijano fired one round from the gun which struck a vehicle in the parking lot, shattering the back window and the bullet lodged in the back of the headrest of the passenger seat.

Quijano had fled the scene in a vehicle and deputies were able to locate him around 10:40 p.m. at 5 Colony Court where he was taken into custody. He was arrested and charged with Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, Aggravated Battery with a Deadly Weapon and Discharge of a Firearm in Public. He is being held at the Sheriff Perry Hall Inmate Detention Facility on a \$100,000.00 bond.
