FCSO Arrests Man for 5 Counts of Unlawful Sexual **Activity with a Minor**

The Flagler County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) has charged 27 year-old Brandin Deoliveira with five counts of unlawful sexual activity with a minor.

The victim notified FCSO after Deoliveira threatened her and her family if anyone found out about their sexual encounters he would kill them all. At one point Deoliveira showed the victim a firearm that he kept accessible, causing her to fear for her and her family's safety.

Through investigative methods and leads the victim's story was corroborated allowing detectives to make an arrest. Detectives located Deoliveira and he was arrested without incident and charged with five (5) counts of unlawful sexual activity with a minor. A firearm matching the one that was described by the victim was recovered from the suspect's vehicle.

"I commend the victim for her bravery in coming forward," Sheriff Rick Staly said. "This guy took advantage of a child and thought he could scare her into hiding the truth. Fortunately our detectives were able to build the case and he is now in custody at the Green Roof Inn where he will likely start the new

year. There is no room in our community for anyone who wants to take advantage of our children." Deoliveira was booked in to the Sheriff Perry Hall Inmate Detention Facility.
