<u>Deputies Seek Community's Assistance in Identifying</u> <u>Commercial Burglars</u>

Flagler County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the Flagler County Tax Collector's office at 7 Old Kings Road, Unit 12, in Palm Coast just after 5:30 a.m. on Saturday after reports of a commercial burglary. The front glass door had been shattered.

Tax Collector's office personnel responded and reviewed video surviellance for the business which shows two subjects break the glass on the front door with a blunt object and enter the business just after 3:00 a.m. The subjects remove electronics then flee through the door.

Deputies are attempting to obtain additional surveillance footage from surrounding businesses. An image of the vehicle the suspects were traveling in appears to be a white SUV or minivan.



"Even though the incident occurred in the early morning hours, it is possible that someone saw something," Sheriff Rick Staly said. "We're asking the community to come forward with any information that might help. Our team is working hard to locate these criminals."
