## FCSO Participates in Florida Sheriff's Association Statewide Task Force - Operation 'Knot Lit'

Operation 'Knot Lit' will focus on maintaining the safety of roads and waterways in the state of Florida during the Fourth of July holiday weekend.



FCSO will be doing our part by having an increased countywide presence and DUI enforcement in Palm Coast, Bunnell, and Flagler Beach. The Sheriff's Taxi-Patrol car will also be visible in various locations. Additionally, the FCSO Marine unit will be patrolling the intracoastal waterways in order to promote boater safety and deter Boating Under the Influence (BUI).

"The safety of our residents and visitors is what matters the most," Sheriff Rick Staly said. "We want everyone to enjoy the holiday safely. If you plan on drinking, then plan on having a sober ride home. If
