The first of its kind, the FCSO National Night Out Trunk-or-Treat event will allow families to drive-through a line-up of specialized FCSO agency vehicles and displays from other community partners. At each display, a deputy or a community partner will hand out candy to each child in the car.

Much like during a traditional National Night Out event, guests will be able to speak briefly with deputies and learn some quick facts about the vehicle and the specialized unit it supports. Additionally, upon entry, drivers will also receive an FCSO 'Goodie Bag' containing valuable safety information and giveaways for adults.
