Repeat Offender Steals Bicycle, Promptly Gets Arrested

On February 7, 2021, the Flagler County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) responded to the CVS Pharmacy at 5151 Belle Terre Parkway after a report of a stolen Trek bicycle valued at \$1,100. Around the same time, an off-duty FCSO Sergeant observed 21-year-old Ty Allison (DOB 3/1/1999), known to him through previous encounters, on a bicycle matching the description of the stolen bicycle in the Old Kings Commons Shopping Center. Deputies responded to the scene and took Allison into custody and charged him with Grand Theft.

The bicycle was immediately returned to the victim, who was grateful that the FCSO was quickly able to resolve the theft.

Ty Allison is well known to FCSO deputies. Since Allison became an adult in 2018, he has been arrested over 15 times and charged with 30 offenses. The charges include numerous incidents of theft, battery, trespassing, and resisting law enforcement, among others.

“I’m not sure what it is about the Green Roof Inn that keeps this guy coming back time and time again, but it’s apparent that slap-on-the-wrist punishment is not encouraging him to change his ways,” Sheriff Rick Staly said. “The criminal justice system needs to deal strongly with this offender so he will stop preying on the citizens of Flagler County. We are doing our job and now the rest of the system needs to step up and convince him that his continued criminal behavior will not be tolerated. Once again our team, including an off-duty Sergeant, did a great job being observant and tracking down this suspect and returning the stolen bike quickly.”

Allison is currently being held at the Sheriff Perry Hall Inmate Detention Facility on \$2,500.00 bond for the Grand Theft charge.
