Another Drug House Closed in the Mondex, Seizure of Narcotics, 1 Arrest

BUNNELL, FL – The Flagler County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) Special Investigations Unit (SIU) served a narcotics search warrant at 2676 Redwood Street, Bunnell, on November 16. The search warrant stemmed from a previous undercover operation conducted by the SIU.

During the search warrant, Detectives seized several grams of fentanyl, methamphetamine, psilocybin (mushrooms), as well as other drug paraphernalia.

One adult male was located at the residence and taken into custody. Joseph Forbes was arrested on the following charges: possession of fentanyl, possession of methamphetamine, and possession of drug paraphernalia. The case is ongoing, and additional charges are pending.
