18-83126	Disturbance Domestic	Red Oak Place	During a confrontation, S1 grabbed V1 by her throat restricting her ability to breathe. S1 then smacked V1 across her face with an open hand. S1 was transported to FCIF without incident.

18-83121	Baker Act/	Hymon Cir/	Deputies responded in reference to a white male walking around stating that no one was going to mess with him. Deputies arrived on scene the male, S1, was agitated, pacing, sweating profusely, and was wearing fingerless gloves that had padding on the knuckles. S1 refused to follow deputy's commands, and became combative. The Taser was subsequently deployed on S1. After deployment S1 complied and was able to taken into custody. It was learned prior to police contact, S1 had been making suicidal statements to a female friend. S1 had also been partying all night and had taken Molly. S1 was Baker Acted, and taken to FHF for medical clearance.
18-83167	Suspicious Incident/	State Road 100 West/	Black male opened the gate to this property and drove around the back of the property, uninvited. The male's vehicle got stuck in the mud near the well pump. Contact was made with the driver, S1 lives in Daytona Beach, and stated that he was trying to locate a friend's residence and thought that this was it. The property owner did not wish to have S1 trespassed and it did not appear that anything was damaged or stolen.
