Disturbance Physical/ 7283-18/ Kathleen Trail Palm Coast/ Sector 223/ V-1 reported that her boyfriend S-1 woke her up and began punching her in the face after he found text messages in her phone that he did not like. He reportedly strangled her until she lost consciousness. He fled the residence and ran over a neighbor's mailbox prior to law enforcement arrival. V-1 had a large contusion on her left cheek and was transported to FHF for medical treatment. Felony Battery by strangulation and battery charges were signed and a BOLO was issued for S-1. The on call victim's advocate responded to FHF to assist V-1.

Warrant Service/7221-18/Beechwood Lane Palm Coast/ Sector 214/ S1 was located and arrested on an active Flagler County warrant for violation of felony probation reference trafficking in stolen property. She was transported to the Flagler County Inmate Facility without incident.

Drunk Person/7243-18/Palm Coast Lanes 11 Old Kings Road N. /Sector 212/ S1 was causing a disturbance by harassing patrons of the business in the bar area of the bowling alley. He refused to leave the establishment and continued his disorderly and disruptive conduct in the presence of law enforcement. He was arrested for disorderly conduct and transported to the FCIF.
