Animal Problem/86290-17/Princess Place, Palm Coast/Sector 212 /Reporting party advised he struck a deer. Report made regarding the call.

Traffic Stop (Narcotics)/86320-17/Old Kings Road/Frontier Drive Palm Coast/Sector 212/Deputy Gaddie initiated a traffic stop on Defendant, D-1, for a traffic infraction. D-1 then was asked to exit the vehicle for a search due to the odor of Cannabis and D-1 continuously reached around the vehicle. D-1 initially was cooperative but then began to actively physically resist to the point where citizens stopped their vehicle's to assist. Backup arrived on scene and D-1 was ultimately placed in custody. A search of the vehicle revealed under 20 grams of marijuana. D-1 was arrested for Battery on LEO, resisting arrest with violence, and possession of marijuana under 20 grams.

Traffic Stop (Narcotics)/86408-17/Ryapple Lane, Palm Coast/Sector 222 /Deputy Conway attempted to stop a vehicle on Ryan Drive, but it continued down Ryapple Lane. D-1 attempted to exit and run into his home, but was detained by Deputy Conway. D-1 was arrested for flee and elude, possession of marijuana with intent to sell, and driving on a suspended driver's license. D-1 was transported to the FCIF for processing without incident.

Disturbance-Physical/86461-17/ E SR 100/Sector 226 /3 subjects (2 males and 1 female) are detained regarding a physical fight that occurred in the Target parking lot. Call still active.
