LEO and school personnel checked the area met with negative results. After further interview, it was discovered that D-1, defendant, made up the entire story. All resources were released from the scene, and D-1 was transported to the FCIF for processing for the charge of filing a false report.

D-1 was charged with battery on LEO, resisting w/o, poss. under 20gr.marijuana, and poss. of paraphernalia. D-1 was transported to the FCIF for processing.
