Burglary Vehicle (Attempted Stolen Vehicle)/ 2017-61995/ Lydenhurst Lane, Palm Coast/ Sector 213/ Victim (V1) stated that sometime during the night an unknown subject entered his unlocked vehicle, used a tool to damage the ignition/locking mechanism, and pushed the vehicle out of the driveway until the steering wheel locked and it could not be pushed any further.
