BOLO	22-87599	US1	S1 being sought for a wellness check in regards to FCSO Case # 2022-000872 was evaluated and found to be of sound mind and released	
Domestic Disturbance	22-87634	Matanzas Woods	S1 was arrested for domestic battery after an altercation with V1 became physical.	
Domestic Disturbance	22-87638	Burning Pl	O1 and O2 were in a verbal altercation. Neither party had any physical injuries consistent with their statements. Due to the inconsistent statements and no physical evidence observed on either party, no arrest were made.	
Baker Act	22-87690	Slocum Path	Adult Female placed into protective custody under a Baker Act.	
BOLO	22-87549	Plantation Bay Rd	Units were dispatched to a "Be on the lookout" (BOLO) for a focus subject. S1 was identified as the driver of a vehicle and was known to be suspended. A traffic stop was initiated and while speaking with the passenger S2, later identified, she provided a false name to the Deputies. Post Miranda she confirmed her true identity and was found to have an active out of county warrant. During a pat down of S2 an obstruction was felt near her upper thigh and she admitted she shoved narcotics down her pants while the traffic stop was being initiated. Prior to being placed in hand cuffs she admitted to having more narcotics in her pants which were turned over to the Deputy. S1 was placed under arrest reference DWLS and drug paraphernalia, S2 was placed under arrest reference providing false name while detained,	

numerous narcotic charges, and an out of county warrant.
