Disturbance Physical	22-2477	Belle Terre Parkway (Publix)	Management from Publix called and advised two separate couples were physically fighting in the store in a shopping aisle. Parties separated prior to LEO arrival. Contact was made with the reported victims whom provided minimal details and did not wish to pursue this incident any further.
