Stolen Tag	19-18776	Richmond Dr	During the investigation of the above recovered stolen tag, it was discovered the vehicle had that belonged on in, removed by an unknown person, and replaced with the aforementioned stolen tag. The victim was unaware that her tag had been stolen, and was unsure of a timeframe when it was stolen. The stolen tag was entered into NCIC as stolen.
Stolen Tag	19-18805	Wheatfield Dr	Temporary tag stolen. The incident occurred between 12p on 02/25 and 9a on 02/26. The tag has been entered in FCIC / NCIC as stolen.
Burglary- Residential	19-18955	Oleander Ave	RP advised that he received an alert that his alarm was going off and observed someone inside his residence and alerted Flagler County Communications. There was a 4-minute time delay and units were dispatched to the area, a perimeter was established, K9 and Fire Flight responded. Deputy Kandour observed two juveniles males walking away from the area from his perimeter point and made contact with them. RP sent a video clip of the incident which shows a white male matching the description of S1 enter the residence then flee. They were both subsequently arrested for Burglary and transported to FCIF without incident.
