<b>Baker Act</b>	19-46561	N Ocean Shore Blvd	Juvenile placed under baker act and transported to Halifax Hospital, DCF notified.
<b>Domestic disturbance w/weapon</b>	19-46594	Louisburg Ln	S1 was arrested and charged with aggravated assault. Due to s1 statements and previous mental health issues a Baker Act form was completed and left at the jail.
<b>Stolen Vehicle Recovered</b>	19-44640	Old Kings Rd N (KFC)	FCSO located a stolen vehicle in the parking lot of KFC. Two occupants were observed exiting the vehicle and entering the store. FCSO conducted a high-risk traffic stop within the parking lot before they could turn the vehicle back on. Both occupants were secured without further incident. The driver, S1, was placed under arrest reference Grand Theft and the passenger, S2, was placed under arrest reference poss marijuana under 20 and poss drug paraphernalia.
<b>Suspicious Incident</b>	19-46512	Beach Village Cir	A citizen found a 3 year old juvenile wondering around Beach Village Apartments. Contact was made with the juvenile's father, who thought the juvenile was asleep in bed. DCF notified.
<b>Larceny</b>	19-46593	Pirate Nation Way (MHS)	Juvenile reported to the SRD that an unknown person stole his "Space Grey Iphone 6" from the boys locker room. At 13:30 the phone was located and returned to the owner.
<b>Warrant</b>	19-46612	Belle Terre Parkway (BTMS)	Juvenile taken into custody for a Flagler County Warrant (FTA). Juvenile arrested and transported without incident.
<b>Trespassing</b>	19-45642	Belle Terre Parkway (WES)	Two adults came on site due to a traffic citation the SRD issued several days ago. Both parties were irate and angry about the citation issued. SRD encountered them in the parking lot of the campus and ordered them to leave. Ultimately both subjects were trespassed from campus.
<b>Domestic Disturbance (physical)</b>	19-46598	Pin Oak Dr	S1 was arrested for domestic battery after she slapped her adult daughter's arm during an altercation. There was video of the incident. S1 was transported to the FCIF without incident.
<b>Death</b>	19-46652	Wood Ash Ln	74 year old was found deceased by his wife. Nothing suspicious was observed.
