| 18-46722 | Domestic Disturbance | Fawn Ln         | O1 was in a verbal argument with her husband O2 over unwashed laundry. O2 broke a pot with flowers in it and left for work. No threats or any acts of physical violence occurred at any time.   |
| 18-46735 | Domestic Disturbance | Buffalo Bill Dr | V1 was in the bedroom, when S1 came into the bedroom and started looking through V1s phone. S1 saw text messages he did not like. S1 locked the bedroom door to talk to V1. V1 wanted to leave and S1 refused to let her leave by standing in the door way. At one point V1 tried to call 911, which caused S1 to hold her down against her will and take the phone. In an attempt to get away from S1, V1 swung a lamp at and hit S1 over the head with a perfume bottle, which caused a small laceration. V1 had a small mark on her arm. It was determined S1 was the primary aggressor and subsequently arrested and charged with Battery, false imprisonment and tampering with a witness. |

When the unknown male saw the RP, he stated he was looking for his dog. The RP stated she is unfamiliar with this male subject.
