18-52683	Disturbance Domestic	S Shady Lane	S1 was located sleeping in his bedroom and placed under arrest for felony battery with prior convictions and felony VOP (charges were passed on from nightshift).
18-52815	Water Rescue	N. Oceanshore Blvd (Beverly Beach Camptown)	Adult female and her juvenile granddaughter drifted approximately 300 to 400 yards off the shore and were not able to swim back in. The juvenile had on a life jacket on but the adult did not. Two Good Samaritans utilized a paddleboard and inner tube to reach the subjects after approximately 40 minutes of being in the water. Two firefighters also swam out to the subjects and helped everyone to shore. A memorandum was sent through the chain of command to recognize the citizens for their assistance.
18-52903	Crash With Injuries	N. Oceanshore Blvd	A motorcycle crashed into the back of a Honda Civic traveling north on A1A. The male driver was not wearing a helmet and hit his head on the pavement when he was thrown from the motorcycle. Northbound lane was temporarily shut down. The subject had non-life threatening injuries.
18-52909	Larceny-Shoplifter	Cypress Point Pwy Walmart	S1 was seen by loss prevention concealing several items, then exit without paying for the items. S1 was stopped outside by LEO and was taken into custody. S1 was arrested for retail theft.
18-52953	Larceny-Shoplifting	Palm Coast Pwy Kohls	S1 entered the dressing room at Kohls with \$196.92 worth of merchandise in a cart. When she left, she no longer had the cart, only a big purse. The dressing room was checked but there were no clothes. S1 was stopped by loss prevention and the items were recovered. S1 was given a Notice To Appear for retail theft.
18-52927	Suspicious Vehicle	S. Old Dixie Hwy	Deputies conducted patrol at the abandoned motel on S. Old Dixie Hwy. As he was leaving he observed a suspicious vehicle pull behind the building. Deputies then made contact with two subjects who stated that they were "being nosy". During the investigation, K9 responded and alerted on the vehicle but no contraband was located.
