Burglary Vehicle (attempt)	<b>94256-18</b>	Lindsay Drive	RP was reviewing video activations from the night and observed a suspect attempt to open the car doors on their vehicle at 12:41am on 10-6-18. The suspect appeared to be a white male wearing a hoodie sweatshirt, pants, and wearing a back pack. The suspect left his bicycle at the beginning of the driveway and walked up to the vehicles. Video was uploaded to Aegis. The vehicles were not entered and no other vehicle burglaries were reported.
Death	<b>94332-18</b>	Covington Ln	61 YOA female found by her husband on the bathroom floor, unresponsive, with fluid and blood coming from her mouth. CPR was performed by deputy until Rescue arrived on scene who eventually pronounced the female deceased. Female had no major medical issues except a fever recently and did not have a primary Doctor. ISD notified and responded.
Domestic Disturbance	<b>18-94252</b>	Lake Diston Road	S1 reported a physical disturbance with S2 after they were arguing over their Son going with S1 to Thunder Gulch Campground. S1 admitted to swiping items off S2 dresser causing one of the items to hit her. S2 then struck S1 with a baby bottle on top of the head. Both subject's sustained lacerations after falling into rose bushes. Photos were taken of all injuries and uploaded into AEGIS, all subjects refused medical treatment. DV paperwork issued and DCF notified. Both S1 and S2 were arrested for battery (Domestic) and S2 was charged with an additional battery on O1.
