Burglary-Residential	21-35697	Westcedar Lane	The victim reported finding items from his open garage that were now damaged in the street, as well as the residence's mailbox. Everything that was missing from the garage was located in the street in front of the residence. This was believed to happen on 04/17/2021 from 9:00 PM – 9:45 PM.
Baker Act	21-35646	Palmwood Drive	Adult female placed under Baker Act.
Baker Act	21-35662	Wellington Drive	Adult male placed under Baker Act.
Juvenile Incident	21-35659	Sesame Boulevard, Sesame Park	A parent of two juvenile daughters wanted to report several other juveniles at the above park that were picking on her daughters. At the same time there was a physical altercation involving multiple other juveniles. After the altercation, one of the children stated that their older brother would return to "shoot up the park". Law enforcement was able to interview that juvenile and his older brother and determine that the threats were not credible. The older sibling was never at the park today (confirmed by parent) and was unsure why his younger brother would say that, as he had no involvement in the incident.
Overdose	21-35698	Bunker View Drive	An adult male was found unresponsive and displayed signs of overdosing on narcotics. Upon arrival, Deputy S. Smith deployed one dose of Narcan and began CPR. The male positively reacted to the Narcan and made a full recovery on scene.
Baker Act	21-35728	Prince Michael Lane	Adult female placed under Baker Act.
Assault-Battery	21-35729	Old Kings Road N, Bowling Alley	S1 was intoxicated and created a disturbance at the bar in the Bowling Alley. S1 was asked to leave and she refused, subsequently spitting on the bartender. After speaking with witnesses and reviewing the business video surveillance, S1 was placed under arrest for battery and was transported to the Flagler County Inmate Facility.
Domestic Disturbance	21-35739	Riverdale Lane	S1 was placed under arrest for DV aggravated assault after threatening his wife.
Reckless Driver	21-35670	15000 Block of West SR 100	Putnam County Sheriff's Office patched a caller through to Flagler County Dispatch who was reporting a reckless driver driving over 100 mph and switching lanes dangerously. Units responded to search for the vehicle while others positioned ahead of it near CR 25 in case the vehicle refused to stop. The vehicle was located driving east bound at 89 mph on RADAR. It then accelerated to pass vehicles over double yellow lines once Deputy Lichty turned around on the vehicle. He

caught up to it near CR 305 with lights and sirens activated in an attempt to get the vehicle stopped. Tire deflation devices were authorized and deployed effectively at CR 25. The vehicle stopped and the driver was arrested for Fleeing and Eluding.
