18-68324	Battery	Kingswood Drive	V1 advised that while at the gas station he was approached by 10-15 black males who began striking him and kicking him until he became unconscious. V1 drove himself to the ER where he had a visible swollen jaw and a contusion on the right side of his face. V1 did not know who the males were.
18-68335	Domestic Disturbance	Port Echo Ln	S1 was arrested for domestic battery after striking V1 with a closed fist twice after he hit her with a pillow. S1 stated he punched V1 after V1 slapped him in the face. V1 had an injury above her right eyebrow. S1 was arrested and transported to FCIF w/o incident.
18-68318	TS	Belle Terre Pkwy	S1 was arrested for operating a motorcycle without endorsement. During the encounter the subject was found to have a loaded firearm with a round in the chamber; S1 did not have a permit to carry a firearm. The firearm was collected and S1 was arrested for no MC endorsement and carrying concealed weapon.
18-68257	Domestic Disturbance	Ferngate Ln	O1 called 911 stating O2 attempted to take an entire bottle of medication to harm himself. Contact was made with both subjects where conflicting accounts were provided and the accounts changed numerous times when questioned. O2 did not meet baker act criteria at this time and due to conflicting statements, changes in the accounts of the incident, subjects were separated for the evening.
18-68268	Death	Greentree St	Deputies found O1 deceased. There was nothing suspicious, the death appeared to be natural.
