S1 advised the business that she would not be returning the vehicle due to her not knowing where it currently is. S1 has not called Law Enforcement to report the vehicle stolen. Charges for grand theft signed on S1 to be forwarded to the State Attorney's Office.

During the argument, S1 then threatened his wife with a firearm. She was eventually able to flee the residence to a family member's residence where she was able to call Law Enforcement. FCSO responded to the apartment and made phone contact with S1. He was cooperative and came outside the residence where he was arrested for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and domestic battery and transported to the inmate facility without incident.
