| Stolen Vehicle (Recovered) | 21- 84929 | Bulldog Drive | Deputies located an unoccupied 2006 Silver Nissan, Florida tag. The vehicle was confirmed stolen out of Lee County. |
| Commercial Burglary | 21-84959 | Palm Harbor Village Way (Portugal Wine Bar & Grill) | Originally called in as an alarm, Deputies located a side door with the glass smashed out. Owner arrived on scene and verified cash register containing approximately \$1000.00 was stolen. |
| Baker Act | 21- 84890 | Eagle Harbor Trail | Juvenile placed in protective custody under a Baker Act. |
| Narcotics | 21-84946 | Flagler Plaza Drive (Hampton Inn) | S1 was found passed out in a vehicle with the door open in the hotel parking lot. Once deputies were able to wake him, S1 was found to be in possession of a small amount of marijuana and a glass pipe. When Deputies attempted to secure S1 in handcuffs, he tried to flee and threw objects into the wood line. Cpl. deployed his TASER which was successful in subduing S1 long enough to get him secured. A search of the wood line produced four baggies containing a powdery substance. S1 was charged with possession of methamphetamine and fentanyl, tampering with evidence, resisting arrest, and possession of drug paraphernalia. |
