Grand Theft	2018-91285	Woodhollow Ln	S1 stated she was missing approximately 20 of her prescribed Hydrocodone pills from her prescription bottle. S1 advised she believes her adult son, S2, who resides in the home with her, took the pills. S1 refused to complete a written statement and declined acceptance of a Victim Rights Brochure. Contact could not be made with S2 at this time.
Suspicious Incident	2018-91316	Seven Wonders Trl.	Call originally reported by a 3rd party caller S1, not on scene, as a robbery of a person. S1 stated she received a phone call from her son S2 who advised her he was just "robbed". S2 stated he took \$485.00 in cash from his mother's room, and unknown subjects arrived at his residence to take the money. S2 stated he was showing the cash on snapchat, and the unknown subjects saw his Snapchat story and got his number from another friend. Video surveillance discounted S2 allegations and he refused to complete a sworn written statement on the incident. S1 advised she did not wish to have S2 complete a statement, as she did not want her son getting in trouble for filing a false police report.
Physical Disturbance -DV	2018-91262	Sea Flower Path	S2 reported she and her husband, S1 were involved in an argument, when S1 struck her in the back with an open hand. S1 was arrested reference DV Battery and transported to FCIF. All DV paperwork provided to the victim.
Verbal Disturbance -DV	2018-91273	Reidsville Dr.	S1 and S2 husband and wife, and reside together at this address. The pair were involved in a verbal disturbance regarding marital problems. Both parties advised there was no violence or threats of violence, and the altercation was strictly verbal. Both parties were provided DV paperwork and neither wished to vacate the residence.
Missing Person-Adult	2018-91282	Buttonwood Dr	S1 stated that on the 23rd he picked up S2 from rehab. He said later that day she went missing and he was worried she was hanging out again with other addicts. S1 said S2 is known to hang out at a homeless camp located near Linear Park off Colbert lane. S1 also stated that he has tried to call her and her phone goes right to voicemail. Units checked Linear park and were UTL. S2 was entered into FCIC/NCIC as a missing person.

Physical Disturbance	2018-91295	Reindeer Ln	S1 (17 YOA male) stated he and his mother S2 were involved in a verbal disturbance. S1 stated an adult male roommate in the home S3 did not like the way S1 was speaking to his mother and placed S1 in a "headlock". S2, S3 and an older sibling of S1 discounted S1 statements, advising no physical altercation occurred. All additional parties advised S1 was unhappy about having his cell phone taken by his mother for discipline, as well as having his bedroom door removed from the hinges, and stated he was calling the police if they didn't put his bedroom door up. No signs of a physical disturbance, and no visible injuries on any party present. Online DCF report submitted.
Suspicious Incident-Welfare Check	2018-91322	Pine Circle Dr.	O-1 contacted the Sheriff's Office reference wishing to report her 60 YOA daughter S1 missing. O1 stated S1 resides by herself in her home on Pine Circle Dr. O1 advised she received information that S1 was in Texas and Oklahoma within the last 2 days. Contact was attempted with the subject that advised O1 of S1 location with negative results. Information will be passed on to dayshift to attempt contact with the subject in Oklahoma, where contact was made with S1. A BOLO was issued to attempt a welfare check on S1.
Fraud	2018-91344	Raemoor Dr	The manager of Domino's Pizza stated one of his delivery drivers made a delivery to this address and collected a \$50.00 bill for payment. Upon the conclusion of her shift, the employee determined the \$50.00 bill was counterfeit. Mgr stated the suspect was a "short, blonde woman" but could not provide any further information. A request for a photo line-up was emailed to the crime analyst. Follow up will be conducted in an attempt to positively identify the suspect(s).
Verbal Disturbance -Domestic	2018-91308	Reine Pl	S1 and S2 were involved in a verbal disturbance. The two reside together and have a child in common. During the argument, S1 grabbed their child and was going to leave the residence. S2 advised him not to leave, or she would call the FCSO. S1 in turn called FCSO to inquire about his parental rights. Both parties advised as S1 was attempting to leave, S2 reached into his vehicle in an attempt to take his car keys. In doing so, S2 pushed S1 arm away from him preventing her from taking his car keys from his vehicle. Both parties advised no violence or threat of violence occurred. DCF notified and S2 left the residence with her children to stay at a family member's residence for the night.
Assist other Agency	2018-91359	Black Bear Ln	DCF called and advised that an 18month old was transported to FHF Orlando from Flagler Hospital in reference to a possible overdose on Subutex. They then advised that the child was in intensive care being monitored. Contact was made at the residence with grandmother who said the incident occurred while her daughter was out at the store with her new boyfriend. Contact made with daughter and boyfriend who provided conflicting statements as to what actually occurred. ISD was call and Det. Fuentes responded to the scene.
Disturbance Domestic	2018-00091313	Clove Av.	Units responded to a verbal disturbance between boyfriend, S2, and girlfriend, S1; child in common. Verbal argument over a cell phone and relationship issues. There were no reported injuries and all of the parties advised it was only verbal. A scratch was observed on S1 arm; however, she advised it was unintentional when she and

S2 were both reaching for the cell phone. S2 left the residence for the evening voluntarily.
