He then checked inside the residence and observed a door in his bathroom that leads to the outside patio, partially open. O1 did not observe anything but heard a vehicle leaving at a high rate of speed. FCSO observed a white Volkswagen, Fla tag # LIY-Q41 in the immediate area and followed it. A traffic stop was conducted on the vehicle after it continued to travel in residential neighborhoods without any reason to be in those areas. Contact was made with O1 (driver), O2, and O3. All three subjects advised post Miranda that they were in the immediate area of Woodshaw Lane but denied being involved with the attempted burglary. Email sent to TIPS. A search of the vehicle did provide anything further to assist in our investigation. Both juvenile's parents were notified of the situation. |
