Baker Act	20-83563	N. Ocean Shore Blvd Lot	Juvenile was taken into protective custody for a Baker Act
Disturbance Weapons	20-83624	Zoffinger Pl	RP located O1 and S1 arguing near Zoffwood Place. RP said that S1 entered her home and returned with a handgun and pointed the handgun at her. Conflicting statements were obtained. Charges for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon submitted to the SAO.
Shooting	20-83562	Becket Ln	S1 and his wife were arguing over their divorce, s1 retrieved a 38 revolver and discharged it in the front yard one time. S1 surrendered to LE peacefully and was secured without incident. Charges were forwarded to discharging firearm and RPO completed.
Suspicious incident	20-83601	Palm Coast Pkwy	Suspicious incident reported by workers. FCSO responded.
Disturbance (Domestic)	20-83646	Clove Ave	S1 repeatedly punched the victim, who is 9 months pregnant, with a closed fist and also struck her with a baseball bat, ultimately being stomped while on the ground. The victim had significant but non-life threatening injuries that corroborated her story. S1 was placed in custody for aggravated battery on a pregnant female and was transported to the Flagler County Inmate Facility without incident.
Disturbance (Weapons)	20-83559	Clove Ave	O1 arrived at this residence with a rifle to look for his missing cell phone who he believed his friend, O2 stole from him earlier today. No threats were made with the firearm, however O2 grabbed the weapon and a struggle ensued, resulting in an accidental discharge of one round through the floor. No injuries were sustained. Contact was made with O1 at his residence where he was served with a trespass warning at O2 request.
