Domestic Disturbance	20-84236	Wavering Place	S1 was involved in a physical disturbance with his mother. S1 was arrested in reference to Domestic Battery. Once in contact he also met BA criteria. He was first transported to FCIF without incident and then upon his release to Halifax.
Missing Person (Adult)	20-84329	Sloganeer Trail	RP stated that he went to check on M1 and realized he was missing (1-hour time delay). A perimeter was established and Sgt. Gimbel responded with K-9. A search was conducted of the area but we were unable to locate M1. M1 was entered into FCIC/NCIC as missing.
Baker Act	20-84338	Birchbark Lane	FCSO received information, that a white female juvenile was possibly at the residence, and had made threats to kill herself. S1, the juvenile's mother, obstructed law enforcement from their lawful duties in an effort to stop law enforcement from placing the juvenile into protective custody. S1 was ultimately arrested for resisting arrest without violence. DCF was notified. W/F Juvenile was transported to Halifax Hospital.
