FCSO Gives Incident Survival Presentation at Palm Coast Charter School

This morning Flagler County Sheriff Rick Staly and the Flagler County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) Domestic Homeland Security Section gave an Incident Survival Presentation at the Imagine School at Town Center in Palm Coast.



The training is to ensure that faculty and students will be able to respond correctly should they be faced with an active incident during school hours. The Incident Survival presentation also touched on how to identify a potential active shooter amongst them before an attack.

This training also serves to fulfill criteria for Florida's new Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School

Public Safety Act that requires Active Shooter Training in schools at least once per semester. This training will be taught to faculty members as well as students by members of the Sheriff's Office Domestic Homeland Security Section and School Resource Deputies.

“The need for Incident Survival Training increases with each significant event that occurs within our schools and other location where these active killers target our people,” Sheriff Staly said. “Just like fire drills and other emergencies, we want to give teachers and students the ability to immediately assess the threat and spring into action to protect themselves and each other.”
