DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Business Services Director will direct and oversee the financial activities of the Flagler County Sheriff's Office, direct the preparation of current financial reports and summaries, and create forecasts predicting future growth.

- Oversees Finance Section, budget preparation, and audit functions.
- Works with other department heads to monitor each department and make recommendations.
- Directs the preparation of all financial statements, including income statements, balance sheets, shareholder reports, tax returns, and governmental agency reports;
- Develops and compiles data for financial reports;
- Prepares revenue forecasts;
- Prepares schedules, analyze financial data, control budgets and other specialized reports;
- Reviews planning process and suggests improvements to current methods;
- Analyzes operations to identify areas in need of reorganization, downsizing, or elimination;
- Works with the Sheriff and other executives to coordinate planning and establish priorities for the planning process;
- Studies long-range economic trends and projects their impact on Agency;
- Prepares and administers agency grants and trust funds;
- Performs other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM SELECTION CRITERIA:

- Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university with a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration, Accounting or Finance (Master's Degree in same fields, preferred);
- Certified Public Accountant designation, preferred;
- Eight (8) to ten (10) years of experience in financial management;
- A combination of Certifications and experience will be considered
- Must have a valid Florida driver's license.
