K-9 Deputy Takes Bite Out of Crime

Deputies responded to a 9-1-1 call from Big Bear Lane in Palm Coast for a report of a car burglary. Deputies met with a victim who reported seeing a male take money from his vehicle and run down the street. A perimeter was established and Corporal Gimbel and his K-9 partner Marko apprehended the suspect.

During the apprehension, K-9 Marko bit the suspect on his forearm. He was placed under arrest and transported to Florida Hospital Flagler for treatment of the wound before being taken to the Flagler County Detention Facility.

"Sometimes it's painful to be a dirtbag," Sheriff Rick Staly said. "He was treated and is now in the Green Roof Inn where he belongs."

Deon Oneal Jenkins was arrested for burglary of an automobile, trespassing, petit theft, and resisting arrest without violence. Jenkins also had an out of county warrant from Volusia County for violation of probation on a domestic violence charge. He is in jail with no bond.
