Fugitive Friday Bingo Spotlight Arrested Off Community Tip

On Friday, March 2, James Raposa, 21, was featured as Sheriff Rick Staly's fugitive of the week on Fugitive Friday Bingo. The video was viewed over 1,100 times and shared 27 times. On Saturday, March 10 just before midnight, an anonymous tip was called into the Flagler County Sheriff's Office Communications Center that stated Raposa could be located at 86 Ulaturn Trail in Palm Coast.

Deputies confirmed Raposa's active warrant and responded to the address where they took Raposa into custody. Raposa was booked into the Flagler County Detention Facility and is held on a \$2,500 bond.

"The video series is working," Sheriff Staly said. "Our Fugitive Unit does a great job tracking down these offenders but no one knows where they are better than family members or friends. In this case, we tracked him faster thanks to the help of our community. Now he is off the streets and in jail where he belongs."
