FCSO and JAXImpact Talk Sober Driving at Flagler Palm Coast High School

The Flagler County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) and JAXImpact gave two separate presentations to students at Flagler Palm Coast High School on Thursday morning about the importance of driving responsibly. Lead by Carl Harms, the presentation focused on making seniors aware of the dangers and potentially fatal outcome of driving impaired.

At the presentation, students were able to hear real life accounts from parents of teens whose lives were lost as a direct result of a DUI crash. Afterwards students were invited to observe a real DUI crash car and the Sheriff Taxi Car.
