Patrol units will have increased presence throughout the weekend with seatbelt, speed, and aggressive driving enforcement along with countywide DUI enforcement. The newly re-launched Marine/Beach unit will be patrolling the beaches and intra-coastal waterways to promote boater safety and deter Boating Under the Influence (BUI).
