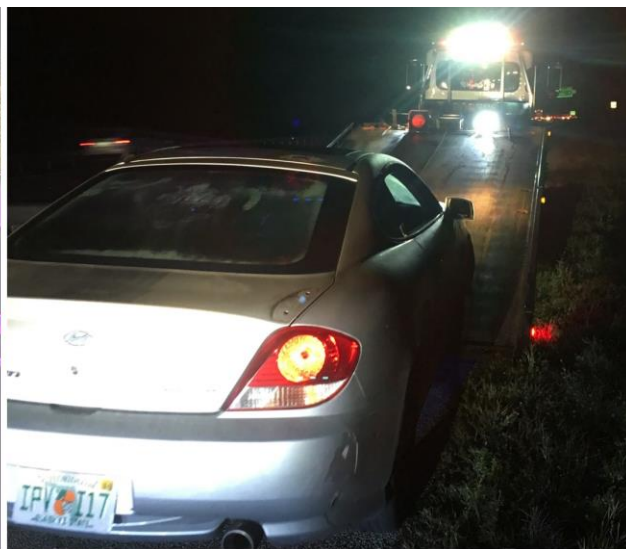

Reckless Driver Arrested By Sheriff Staly

Crime never sleeps and neither does the law, as one reckless driver found out Thursday night, December 21st, 2017. And just who was the lawman to make the traffic stop? Flagler County Sheriff Rick Staly!

The Sheriff was heading eastbound on SR-100 at about 8:30pm, approaching Seminole Woods Blvd, when a silver 2 door Hyundai approached his unmarked vehicle at a high rate of speed weaving in and out of traffic. The sheriff went to catch the car who by now was accelerating at speeds over 112 mph northbound on I-95 and weaving through heavy traffic. The Sheriff was able to catch up with the car on I-95, just south of the 289 mile marker. The driver, David Reardon, was arrested for will and wonton reckless driving and possession under 20 grams of marijuana after a search of his vehicle. Reardon told Sheriff Staly he was in a hurry "to get home to let his dogs out." I-95 is the number 2 crash area in the county.
